More than 15,000 Colorado Children are abducted each year according to the Colorado Bureau of Investigation. In the event that your child ever becomes missing or separated from you, the Colorado Masonic Child Identification Program gives law enforcement and recovery officials essential materials to help find your child.

This program is designed to help parents keep current information on their children, so they have it readily available in case the worst happens. If something does happen, such as abduction, the faster you can provide accurate and complete information to the authorities, the better the chances are of a happy ending.

What is included in this program?

- A digital photograph.
- Fingerprints – Fingerprints are taken with an electronic scanner, no ink is involved.
- Pertinent data information is supplied by the parents such as age, height, weight, distinguishing features, like birthmarks, etc.
- The parents leave with a single document that they can use in case of emergency. None of the information recorded is saved or recorded.
